Welcome to worship today! In today's service, you can expect to experience "water sprinkling" during the opening song as the congregation is invited to remember their baptisms. We use small wooden sprinklers called aspergillums to take water from the font and sprinkle it on the congregation. During the offering, we will collect "noisy offering," which is change dropped into metal buckets that goes to support local organizations. The idea is for it to be noisy, so the offering time will be a bit louder than usual. If any of these things are hard for you, know that the narthex (the entrance area outside of the sanctuary) will be a dry and quieter spot during those parts of the service.






*The Lord's Prayer


 C Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.


Communion Distribution


